Clinicians will get a didactic portion of information and practice with the presenter extensively with pig jaws after live-demonstrations.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

◆ Soft Tissue Management:

Practice of Incisions and Flap Elevation, Crown Lengthening procedures, Flap Closure/Advancement, Partial Thickness Flap, Management of Surgical Complications, Bone Grafting and Laser-Assisted Periodontal Applications Clinicians will learn when, why and how to proceed in surgical periodontology and oral surgery utilizing innovation in surgical dentistry.

This action-packed Soft-Tissue Management course, with multiple hands-on sessions and lectures, will provide a step-by-step blueprint for successful Soft-Tissue and Surgical techniques with hand instruments, piezoelectric devices and lasers.

Dr. Romanos will provide pre-op patient evaluation and safe patient selection and you will leave prepared to return to your practice and immediately provide these new techniques and procedures. You will learn how to select and demonstrate proficient use of the appropriate armamentarium to determine and demonstrate case-appropriate basic and advanced suturing techniques. The course has been carefully designed to integrate didactic, and visual aides, and extensive hands-on attendee participation with a wide range of different exodontia and grafting procedures for each individual patient.

◆ Hard Tissue (Bone) Grafting:

At this intensive two-day hands-on

workshop, attendees will learn the fundamental principles and specific protocols used to perform guided bone regeneration (GBR) and in general bone grafting techniques. This course will focus on the hard tissue management and will provide important information for the clinician who wants to improve his knowledge and wants to be trained comprehensively in all these surgical techniques from a world-class expert.

Each participant will learn numerous protocols for the management of simple socket defects, advanced socket defects, horizontal and vertical ridge augmentation (incl. sinus) using GBR and block techniques.

This course will focus on proper planning and execution of predictable bone grafting techniques to restore a patient's smile and function with dental implants. At the same time learning how to implement these techniques to achieve safe and predictable treatment outcomes. This 18-hour course is unlike most you will attend and offers follow up sessions to review cases post-course through the new Goldman Dental Study Club.

Participants will learn indications and contraindications of different hard tissue procedures and will perform frequently in an ex vivo model (under direct supervision) all the surgical procedures included in the program. Special focus on the hard

tissue surgical techniques for Implant Dentistry!

2. Periosteal Releasing Incision for flap advancement (*incl. hands on*)
3. Pre-prosthetic surgical procedures (vestivuloplasties) (*incl. hands on*)
4. Blood Vessel Ligature (*incl. hands on*)
5. Nerve Preparation (*incl. hands on*)
6. Crown Lengthening procedures (*incl. hands on*)
7. Gingival Grafts (i.e., FGG, CTG) (*incl. hands on*)
8. Socket Preservation techniques (*incl. hands on*)
9. Bone Spreading – Splitting (*incl. hands on*)
10. Guided Bone Regeneration technique (*incl. hands on*)
11. Complications and their management from soft tissue and bone grafting (*incl. hands on*)

College of Dentists, ICOI, Pierre Fauchard Academy; Great of NY Academy of Prosthodontics, Intern. Academy for Dental Facial Esthetics and the American College of Dentists. He has global educational and research activities, author of more than 500 publications, top 2% of scientists worldwide according to the AD scientific index; editor and co-editor in eight books; >700 lectures in more than 50 countries; Recipient of the Distinguished Scientist Award from the American Academy of Periodontology (AAP), the Distinguished Scientist Award for Prosthodontics and Implant Research from the IADR, the Outstanding Educator and Maiman Research Award from the Academy of Laser Dentistry; h-Index: 88; >26,000 citations.
